WHEREAS, after a successful judicial career spanning a period of twenty years, Judge Curran is retiring therefrom on May 31, 1984; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of the City, does hereby extend this expression of appreciation and gratitude for a career of dedicated and distinguished public service, to the Honorable Richard J.
