RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO ORDER CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE STANDLEY PARK ASSESSMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, an assessment district was formed for the construction of park and recreation facilities on Standley Park and adjoining properties of the San Diego Unified School District and the formation in the University City area of a park and special assessment district known as the Standley Park Assessment District pursuant to the San Diego Park District Procedural Ordinance of 1969; and

WHEREAS, the Standley Park Assessment District has completed all of the improvements described in Resolution No. R-212224; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to amend the work to be done pursuant to Streets & Highways Code Section 10353 to provide for additional work using surplus funds available in the district; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The Council hereby initiates proceedings for the revision of the work to be done in the Standley Park Assessment District pursuant to the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 (commencing with Section 10000, Streets and Highways Code).

Section 2. The public interest and convenience require and the Council of said city hereby declares its intention to order

changes and revisions to the improvements made within said city, such revisions to the improvements being described as follows, to wit:

I. The construction and installation of certain park and recreation facilities and appurtenances and appurtenant work on portions of the park described as follows:

- A. Provide a referee's chair and two viewing benches.
- B. Provide three benches between the tennis courts.
- C. Construct a skylight at the handball courts.
- D. Construct an enclosure for a small truck and for trash cans.
- E. Construct an extension to the small childrens' play area.
- F. Reconstruct the lobby and other portions of the recreation center.
- G. Construct a concrete walkway along the westerly side of the swimming pool.
- H. Construct a 14 ft. x 20 ft. masonry storage building.
- I. Construct a concrete curb under an existing chain link fence.
- J. Relocate an existing backstop.
- K. Install a picnic table and a barbeque.
- L. Remove an existing backstop.
- M. Install a new backstop.
- N. Install bleachers.
- O. Replace 120 ft. of 10 ft. high chain link fence with 120 ft. of 20 ft. high chain link fence.

P. Install a 30 ft. light pole.

II. All of the public park improvements are to be constructed at the places and in the particular locations, of the forms, sizes, dimensions and materials, and at the lines, grades and elevations as shown and delineated upon the plans, profiles and specifications to be made therefor, as hereinafter provided. All items of work do not necessarily extend for the full length of the description thereof. The plans and profiles of the work as contained in the Engineer's "Report" shall be controlling as to the correct and detailed description thereof.

Section 3. The report of the Superintendent of Streets for the proposed improvements to the Standley Park as filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 260960-1 be and the same is hereby approved.



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on July 17, 1984 at 2:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, Community Concourse, 202 C Street, in the City of San Diego, California, is the day, hour and place for the hearing when and where any and all persons having any objections or protests as to the proposed work or improvement, to the grades

at which the work is to be done, or to the extent of the district to be assessed, may appear and show cause why the proposed improvement should not be carried out in accordance with the Resolution of Intention; failure to make objections at that time shall be deemed to be a waiver of all objections and shall operate as a bar for any claim for damages.

WHEREAS, an assessment district was formed for the construction of park and recreation facilities on Standley Park and adjoining properties of the San Diego Unified School District and the formation in the University City area of a park and special assessment district known as the Standley Park Assessment District pursuant to the San Diego Park District Procedural Ordinance of 1969; and

WHEREAS, the Standley Park Assessment District has completed all of the improvements described in Resolution No. R-212224; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to amend the work to be done pursuant to Streets & Highways Code Section 10353 to provide for additional work using surplus funds available in the district; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The Council hereby initiates proceedings for the revision of the work to be done in the Standley Park Assessment District pursuant to the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 (commencing with Section 10000, Streets and Highways Code).

Section 2. The public interest and convenience require and the Council of said city hereby declares its intention to order changes and revisions to the improvements made within said city, such revisions to the improvements being described as follows, to wit:
