It is proposed to assess the total amount of maintenance costs of the district, plus the incidental expenses thereto, less a City contribution of \$25 per acre of open space lands to be maintained, to all the real property within the district in conformance with the provisions of the San Diego Maintenance District Procedural Ordinance of 1975 and in proportion to the estimated benefits from the maintenance to be received by the individual parcel of real property.

The Council may order a portion of the costs of maintenance to be paid by the City from appropriate funds.
