WHEREAS, existing law does not contain any special parking or stopping requirements for vehicles which sell or vend items from the vehicles; and

WHEREAS, AB 2249 (Moore) would specifically require any commercial vehicle engaged in vending to be legally parked when vending products on a street in a residential neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, in addition, AB 2249 would authorize city councils to adopt additional public safety regulations governing the operation of commercial vehicles engaged in vending upon a street and such local regulations may include a ban of vending from vehicles upon certain streets; and

WHEREAS, the local regulations can be adopted by ordinance or resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the Council support AB 2249 which would promote child pedestrian safety by authorizing local agencies to regulate the operation of commercial vehicles engaged in vending upon a street; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Relations Department has noted that there have been a number of law enforcement related bills which we have had to bring to your Council because of lack of adopted Council policy to justify taking a position without specific Council action; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department indicates AB 2249 would provide needed authority to: (1) regulate vending vehicles; and (2) promote traffic safety in the vicinity of schools and heavily congested areas; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Relations Department, in IRD Report No. 84-29, dated June 4, 1984, recommended to the Rules Committee on June 11, 1984, that the proposed legislation be supported; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee considered the information and recommendations contained in IRD Report No. 84-29 and unanimously approved said recommendation to support AB 2249 (Moore); and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee now forwards the matter of AB 2249 to the full Council with a recommendation to express the City's support for the bill; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that after full consideration of IRD Report No. 84-29 recommending support of AB 2249 and the recommendation of the Rules Committee to express such support, this Council does hereby declare its support for AB 2249 (Moore) for regulation of Vehicles Vending upon a street in residential neighborhoods.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Intergovernmental Relations Department be and it is hereby directed to take all necessary and appropriate action to comply with the above Council support.
