A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION AND THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, ON JUNE 5, 1984.

WHEREAS, a municipal primary election was held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, June 5, 1984, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 16148 (New Series), for the purpose of nominating candidates; and

WHEREAS, a special municipal election was held in the City of San Diego on the same date, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 16174 (New Series) adopted February 27, 1984, which special election was consolidated with the municipal primary election for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego one proposition relating to ratifying an ordinance authorizing the exchange, sale or lease to the United States of America of portions of Pueblo Lots 1276, 1304, 1305, 1306, 1318 and 1319 of the Pueblo Lands of the City of San Diego as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines, pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.2206 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

I
