WHEREAS, at the June 25, 1984 Rules Committee meeting, the Council's Sacramento Legislative Representative, John Witzel, summarized the provisions of a compromise proposal to provide "long-term, stable" financing for local government; and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of this verbal briefing, staff was directed to provide a written outline of the compromise and its fiscal impact upon the City; and

WHEREAS, the summary of the compromise local government proposal and its fiscal impact upon the City is set forth in IRD Report No. 84-39, dated July 3, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee heard testimony and considered such report and information contained therein and voted unanimously (4-0) to approve and adopt the recommendations contained therein; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee now forwards the matter to the full Council with a recommendation that the Council express support of the IRD recommendations, as set forth in IRD Report No. 84-39, dated July 3, 1984; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, after due consideration and discussion of the information contained in Report No. 84-39 of the Intergovernmental Relations Department, does hereby express its support for the recommendations set forth therein to the extent that:

- (1) The funds described in said report not be allocated pending the outcome of the Jarvis initiative on the November 1984 ballot.
- (2) The City continue to pursue, through the Legislature, a constitutional amendment which would eliminate the Legislature's ability to alter funding formulas for various local subventions, such as vehicle license fees, cigarette taxes, and allocation of all property tax revenues.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby directed to place the sum of \$1,700,000, anticipated as a net fiscal gain for fiscal year 1985 as a result of the proposed legislation and as may be directly attributable thereto, in the Capital Improvement Program Reserve Fund.
