A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE SAN YSIDRO BOULEVARD (VIA DE SAN YSIDRO TO WILLOW STREET) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R-261018, a public hearing was called for on July 31, 1984 at the hour of 2:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within that certain area of the City of San Diego more particularly described as follows:

Lots A through C, the southerly 50 feet of Lots D through F, Lots G through I, the northerly 75 feet of Lot A-23, the easterly 117 feet of Lot A-31, the portion of Lot A-32 north of a line parallel to and 90 feet south to the southerly line of San Ysidro Boulevard, a portion of Lot A-30 beginning at a point 58 feet east of the easterly line of Via De San Ysidro on the southerly line of San Ysidro Boulevard and then bearing south at S28°12'38"W for 83.3 feet, then S00°35'38"W for 62.5 feet, then east at S89°24'22"E for 60.8 feet, then north at N00°35'38"

for 74.2 feet and enidng at the southerly line of San Ysidro Boulevard 108 feet east of the easterly line of Via De San Ysidro, the southerly 80 feet of San Ysidro Park and Recreation Center, SAN YSIDRO MAP 1174.

Said District shall also include the following described public rights-of-way:

SAN YSIDRO BOULEVARD between a line parallel to and 117 feet west of the westerly line of Via De San Ysidro and the easterly line of Willow Road; WEST PARK AVENUE between the northerly line of San Ysidro Boulevard and a line parallel to and 80 feet north of the northerly line of San Ysidro Boulevard; PEPPER DRIVE between the northerly line of San Ysidro Boulevard and a line parallel to and 50 feet north of the northerly line of San Ysidro Boulevard; the northerly half of MAIN STREET between the easterly line of Pepper Drive and the easterly line of East Olive Drive; EAST OLIVE DRIVE between the northerly line of San Ysidro Boulevard and the northerly line of Main Street; WEST OLIVE DRIVE between the northerly line of San Ysidro Boulevard and the northerly line of Main Street; WILLOW ROAD between the southerly line of San Ysidro Boulevard and a line parallel to and 100 feet south of the southerly line of San Ysidro Boulevard.

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.
- 2. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date upon which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution

order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.

The City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service they shall provide at their own expense all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution) and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.
