- 1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to accept, for and behalf of said City, the three (3) Dragon Boats offered as a gift by Singapore.
- 2. That the City Manager be and he is hereby fully authorized to execute and submit the necessary documents and verification required by Customs Form 5291, attached hereto as Attachment A, for the use and files of Barinco International, the brokerage firm that processed importation of the boats and

waiver of customs duty thereon.

3. That this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby extends to the people of Singapore an expression of appreciation for their very generous gift of the three (3) Dragon Boats to San Diego, an action which establishes closer friendship ties between our cities and people.
