## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 261399

ADOPTED ON AUG 26 1984

WHEREAS, Section 8330, et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of an excess right-of-way of a street or highway not required for street or highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, in connection with said vacation, the City desires to reserve certain easements; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the vacation of a portion of the Sports Arena Boulevard and Rosecrans Street intersection adjacent to Lots 3-5 of the Silver Frontier Subdivision, Map 6282, to facilitate development of their property; and

WHEREAS, the portion of the streets to be vacated are not needed for present or prospective public street purposes; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the street to be vacated through will continue to have access; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

WHEREAS, the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the portion of the Sports Arena Boulevard and Rosecrans Street intersection adjacent to Lots 3-5 of the Silver

Frontier Subdivision, Map 6282, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 21348-D on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 261399-( , which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.

- That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, easement, and privilege of placing, constructing, repairing, replacing, maintaining, using, and operating public utilities of any kind or nature, including, but not limited to, water, drain and general utilities and all necessary and proper fixtures and equipment for use in connection therewith, through, over, under, upon, along, and across the hereinafter-described easement, together with the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom, together with the right to maintain the said easement free and clear of any excavation or fills, the erection or construction of any building or other structures, the planting of any tree or trees thereon, or the drilling or digging of any well or wells thereon, together with the right to otherwise protect from all hazards the operation and use of any right hereby reserved. Upon acquisition of encroachment permit from the City Engineer pursuant to the Municipal Code of the City, the owners of the underlying fee may utilize the above-described parcel of land for structures, the planting or growing of trees, or the installation of privately owned pipelines.
- 3. That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, from vacation and abandonment, easements, and rights of any public utility pursuant to any existing franchise or

renewals thereof, at any time, or from time to time, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew, and enlarge overhead or underground lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles, and other structures, equipment, and fixtures for the transportation and distribution of electrical or electronic energy and natural gas, and for incidental purposes including access to protect the property from all hazards in, upon, over, and across the above- described portions of streets to be vacated and abandoned.

4. That the easements reserved herein are in, under, over, upon, along, and across that portion of the Sports Arena Boulevard and Rosecrans Street intersection adjacent to Lots 3-5 of the Silver Frontier Subdivision, Map 6282, vacated by this document and as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 21348-D on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-261339

- 5. That the resolution shall no become effective unless and until the street improvements for Sports Arena Boulevard and Rosecrans Street, as more particularly shown on City Engineer Drawing No. 21252-1-5-D and as authorized by City Engineering Permit No. W-28101 and CALTRANS Encroachment Permit No. 11-83-7RP2333 have been completed, accepted, and opened to public use. In the event that the aforementioned street improvements have not been completed, accepted, and opened to public use by December 15, 1985, this resolution shall become void and be of no further force or effect.
- 6. That the City Engineer shall advise the City Clerk when the aforementioned street improvements have been completed,

accepted, and opened to public use, and that the City Clerk shall then cause a certified copy of this resolution, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.




