BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the projects as identified in Exhibit A are hereby approved for funding allocations under The City of San Diego Single Family Morgage Revenue Bond Program, 1984 Issue B.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the time schedule for development consideration and potential authorization for sale of the bonds, attached hereto as Exhibit B, is hereby approved.
