FINDINGS FOR THE OIC PRECISE PLAN

- 1. Although public services and facilities are not generally available on Otay Mesa, all such public services and facilities are or will be available concurrent with need for OIC because of the diligent planning efforts of the developers over the past several years; and
- 2. The OIC is adjacent to the second border crossing station which will generate demands for a wide variety of support industrial, commercial and administrative/office land uses; some of which demands cannot be readily predicted today, thus demanding flexibility in the OIC Precise Plan; and
- 3. The OIC property is physically suitable for the proposed high intensity land uses by virtue of its gentle topography and geographical location near the border crossing station along with access to major circulation facilities; and
- 4. The OIC Precise Plan is phased such that adequate public facilities and services will be available as needed for each parcel developed; and
- 5. The OIC Precise Plan is consistent with the amended Otay Mesa Community Plan and the City's Progress Guide and General Plan which designates the subject property as a Precise Plan Area; and

- 6. The OIC Precise Plan is consistent with the Otay

 Mesa Development District because it implements the

 Development District with appropriate procedures, regulations
 and controls within the Precise Plan Text; and
- 7. Appropriate measures have been incorporated into the Precise Plan to mitigate potential significant adverse environmental impacts; and appropriate environmental findings are, made supported by facts brought forth in the Environmental Impact Report, in the Precise Plan Text, staff reports, correspondence and public testimony; which has been made part of the public record; and
- 8. Approval of the OIC Precise Plan will not cause any detrimental impacts to adjacent property because the uses proposed for this project are compatible with the designated land uses on the adjacent property; and
- 9. The OIC Precise Plan Text contains the necessary land use regulations and controls to assure orderly development of the property while permitting the necessary flexibility of land uses to assure development which is responsive to the needs and demands created by the Second Border Crossing Station.
