A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE  
GENERAL AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS HELD  
IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, ON NOVEMBER 6, 1984.

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held in the City of San Diego, on Tuesday, November 6, 1984, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. O-16246 (New Series), for the purpose of electing a Mayor; and

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was held in the City of San Diego on the same date pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. O-16247 (New Series) adopted July 23, 1984, which Special Municipal Election was consolidated with the General Municipal Election for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego one proposition relating to authorizing the acceptance from the Salk Institute for Biological Studies (Salk) of a portion of Pueblo Lot 1324 consisting of 2.57 acres of Salk property to be added to Torrey Pines City Park and authorizing the acceptance in addition of \$350,000.00 to be used for park acquisition and improvements, in exchange for a conveyance by the City to Salk of 2.3 acres of dedicated Torrey Pines City Park Land now used and to be used by Salk for research purposes and one proposition relating to an advisory measure in connection with the name of San Diego Jack Murphy Stadium as follows:
