A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC STREETS, HIGHWAYS, AND SERVICE EASEMENTS VACATION LAW, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE COOLIDGE AND BURTON STREETS ADJACENT TO LOTS 3 AND 4, BLOCK 63, AND LOTS 6 AND 8 THROUGH 10, BLOCK 59; THE NORTH/SOUTH ALLEY ADJACENT TO LOTS 2 THROUGH 5, BLOCK 63; AND EAST/WEST ALLEY ADJACENT TO LOTS 1, 2, 5, 6 AND 7, BLOCK 63; AND THE WALK ADJACENT TO LOTS 8 AND 9, BLOCK 59, ALL IN LINDA VISTA UNIT 4, MAP 3256, AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the public interest and convenience of said City require the vacation of Coolidge and Burton Streets adjacent to Lots 3 and 4, Block 63, and Lots 6 and 8 through 10, Block 59; the north/south alley adjacent to Lots 2 through 5, Block 63; and east/west alley adjacent to Lots 1, 2, 5, 6 and 7, Block 63; and the walk adjacent to Lots 8 and 9, Block 59, all in Linda Vista Unit 4, Map 3256; and in connection therewith require the reservation of certain easements for general utilities.
- 2. That it is the intention of said Council to order the vacation of Coolidge and Burton Streets adjacent to Lots 3 and 4, Block 63, and Lots 6 and 8 through 10, Block 59; the north/south alley adjacent to Lots 2 through 5, Block 63; and east/west alley adjacent to Lots 1, 2, 5, 6 and 7, Block 63; and the walk adjacent to Lots 8 and 9, Block 59, all in Linda Vista Unit 4, Map 3256, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 21322-D on

file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-262172 .

- 3. That the Council hereby elects to proceed, in making said vacation, under the provisions of the "Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law."
 - 4. That the Council hereby fixes 10:00 a.m. _Jan. 15, 1985,
- , in the Council Chambers on the twelfth floor of the City Administration Building, Charles C. Dail Concourse, 202 "C" Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.
- 5. That The Daily Transcript, a daily newspaper published and circulated, and of general circulation, in the said City of San Diego, be, and it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, and the Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be posted in the manner and form required by law and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in said newspaper in the manner required by law.
