AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16214 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULED OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85" BY AMENDING EXHIBITS A AND B THERETO TO CREATE THE NEW CLASSIFICATION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COORDINATOR AND ESTABLISH A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Division of the Property Department recently received approval to reorganize in order to decrease the span of control of the Deputy Director; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Director currently has direct supervision of ten employees in the administration of a variety of community development projects and under the approved reorganization, the span of control will be reduced by assigning one of the current Community Development Specialist IV positions to supervise three of the remaining Community Development Specialist IV positions; and

WHEREAS, as a result, it will be necessary to reclassify the new supervisory position to provide for an appropriate supervisory differential; and

WHEREAS, in addition, a review of the Open Space Acquisition Coordinator position in the Park and Recreation Department indicates a similar supervisory differential problem; and

WHEREAS, this position is currently classified as a Community Development Specialist IV and is assigned to supervise a Project Officer I; and

WHEREAS, the current salary differential between Community Development Specialist IV (\$2546-\$3087) and Project Officer I (\$2478-2995) is only 3.1%; and

WHEREAS, each of these positions is responsible for planning, budgeting, coordinating, and implementing specific development and open space acquisition projects and these are duties which are typical of those performed by Community Development Specialists, however, there is currently no classification in this series which is at a high enough salary level to provide an appropriate supervisory differential for these positions; and

WHEREAS, the creation of the new class of Community Development Coordinator, at a salary equal to that of Senior Civil Engineer (\$2856-\$3458), is recommended to accommodate the above recited situation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 0-16214 (New Series), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85" be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Exhibit B thereto to create and establish the classified position of Community Development Coordinator.

Section 2. As a schedule of compensation for the position created in Section 1 above, the following standard rate number of the Tables of Classes and Standard Rates is hereby established and adopted.

STANDARD RATE NO.

Community Development Coordinator 35.0

Section 3. The position of Community Development Coordinator shall be inserted in Exhibit B to Ordinance No. O-16214 (New Series), as amended, under the general category of Management, Fiscal and Staff in front of the position of Telecommunications Systems Manager.


Section 4. The Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to amend, as necessary, Exhibit A to Ordinance No. O-16214 (New Series), as amended, by calculating and inserting in said Base Salary Table, the following new rate:

<u>RATE</u>	<u>RANGE (STEP A-E)</u>
35.0	\$2,856 - \$3,458 (monthly)

Section 5. Pursuant to Section 8 of Ordinance No. O-16214 (New Series), as amended, the above newly created position, with the concurrence of the Civil Service Commission and City Manager, shall be and is hereby designated to be eligible for regular rate overtime. The Personnel Director is hereby directed to include such designation in the Personnel Manual of The City of San Diego.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
