

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 16378 (New Series)

ADOPTED ON FEB 26 1985

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-16249 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-16249-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY ADDING TO THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT (065), 8.00 POSITIONS, AS SPECIFIED HEREIN; DELETING FROM THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE BUILDING INSPECTION DEPARTMENT (130), 5.30 POSITIONS, AS SPECIFIED HEREIN; TRANSFERRING WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND 100, THE SUMS OF \$71,870 FROM THE BUILDING INSPECTION DEPARTMENT (130) AND \$20,367 FROM THE UNALLOCATED RESERVE (605) TO THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT (065), FOR THE PURPOSE OF FULLY FUNDING THE ABOVE AUTHORIZED POSITIONS FOR THE SIGN ENFORCEMENT FUNCTION FOR THE REMAINDER OF FISCAL YEAR 1984-85, AS SPECIFIED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, on February 11, 1985, the Rules Committee considered the matter of consolidating the sign enforcement function within the Planning Department effective March 1, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the Committee considered the fiscal impact of such move and also discussed and deliberated upon the personnel requirements; and

WHEREAS, such consolidation requires the deletion of 5.30 positions from the Building Inspection Department currently assigned to this task, with appropriate transfer of funds associated with personnel and non-personnel costs; and

WHEREAS, the consolidation also requires the addition of 8.00 positions to the Planning Department with funds to defray personnel and non-personnel costs in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee unanimously approved (5-0) the proposal for consolidating the sign enforcement function and now forwards the matter to the full Council for approval and enactment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16249 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-16249-1, as amended and adopted therein, by adding to the personnel authorization schedule of the Planning Department (065), 8.00 positions as identified and set forth in Attachment "A" hereto, entitled "Proposed Consolidation of Sign Enforcement Function."


Section 2. That the above specified budget ordinance be and the same is hereby further amended by deleting from the personnel authorization schedule of the Building Inspection Department (130), 5.30 positions, as identified and set forth in Attachment "A" hereto.

Section 3. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to transfer within the General Fund 100, the sums of \$71,870 from the Building Inspection Department (130) and \$20,367 from the Unallocated Reserve (605) to the Planning Department (065), to be allocated to those categories as are specified in Attachment "A" hereto, for the sole and exclusive purpose of fully funding the above authorized

positions for the sign enforcement function for the remainder of Fiscal Year 1984-85.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two (2) public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego; provided, however, that the addition and deletion of positions, the transfer of funds, and consolidation and assignment of sign enforcement functions in the Planning Department shall be effective March 1, 1985..
