AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-16249 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 00-16249-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY AMENDING SECTION 2.VI, ENTITLED "ENTERPRISE FUNDS" TO ADD THERETO A NEW FUND ENTITLED "BUILDING INSPECTION ENTERPRISE FUND (41300)"; AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR AND COMPTROLLER TO TRANSFER THE ENTIRE APPROPRIATED FY 1985 BUILDING INSPECTION DEPARTMENT (130) BUDGET FROM THE GENERAL FUND 100 TO THE NEWLY CREATED ENTERPRISE FUND (41300); APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$430,565 AS ESTIMATED EXCESS ADDITIONAL REVENUES; AND DIRECTING THE AUDITOR AND COMPTROLLER TO TRANSFER AND ALLOCATE SAID EXCESS ADDITIONAL REVENUES TO THE NEWLY CREATED BUILDING INSPECTION ENTERPRISE FUND (41300) FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING 26.00 ADDITIONAL POSITIONS ON A LIMITED BASIS AS FOLLOWS: PERSONNEL SERVICES - \$380,434 AND NON-PERSONNEL EXPENSES - \$50.131; DECLARING SAID BUILDING INSPECTION ENTERPRISE FUND (41300) EXEMPT FROM THE LIMITATIONS OF PROPOSITION "J" AND THE CALCULATIONS ASSOCIATED THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, at the present time, the Building Inspection

Department is included in the General Fund which is budgeted up

to the Proposition "J" limit; and

WHEREAS, because of this condition, it is not possible to adequately respond to the recent increase in construction industry activity because the spending limit exists even though there is adequate revenue to improve the service; and

WHEREAS, the primary intent of Proposition "J" was to limit appropriation increases in General Government expenditures; however, Proposition "J" excludes certain special funds which are characterized by the fact that the costs of services they provide are entirely offset by user fees or other non-general tax revenues; and

WHEREAS, as per the City Attorney, the passage of State Proposition 4 in 1979 had the effect of making the status of Proposition "J" that of Council Policy and, as such, it is within the City Council's authority to exempt Building Inspection from the Proposition "J" limit; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to exempt the Building Inspection function from Proposition "J" and convert it to an Enterprise Fund; and

WHEREAS, conversion of the Building Inspection Department to an enterprise fund would enable the department to adjust service and staffing to respond to the current demand, and the department would be self-sufficient in that all operating expenses would be offset by revenues from permit fees and related income; and

WHEREAS, the General Fund would annually recover prorated administrative expenses for services of staff departments such as the Auditor and Comptroller, Financial Management, City Treasurer, etc., which are incurred in providing services to the Building Inspection Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, in his Report No. 85-60, dated February 5, 1985, set forth for the information of the Rules Committee, the background, discussion and recommendations in

respect to converting the Building Inspection Department to an enterprise fund and exempting the budgetary allocations thereto from the limitations imposed by Proposition "J"; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee, at its regularly scheduled meeting of February 11, 1985, considered and discussed the information and proposals contained in City Manager Report No. 85-60 and unanimously approved (5-0 vote) the recommendations set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and required to amend the annual appropriation ordinance in order to effectuate said recommendations to convert the Building Inspection Department into an enterprise fund operation and exempt said fund from the limitations of Proposition "J"; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee now forwards the matter to the full Council with a recommendation to enact said amendment to the budget; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16249 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Document No. OO-16249-1, as amended and adopted therein, by amending Section 2.VI, entitled "ENTERPRISE FUNDS" by adding thereto a new fund entitled "BUILDING INSPECTION ENTERPRISE FUND (41300)."


Section 2. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to transfer the entire appropriated Fiscal Year 1985 Building Inspection Department (130) budget from the General Fund 100 to the newly established Building Inspection Enterprise Fund (41300).

Section 3. That estimated excess additional revenue in the amount of \$430,565 be and the same is hereby recognized and appropriated for budgetary purposes.

Section 4. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby directed to transfer and allocate the above appropriated \$430,565 of estimated excess additional revenues to the newly created Building Inspection Enterprise fund (41300) for the purpose of funding 26.00 additional positions on a limited basis, with funding authorized as follows: Personnel Services - \$380,434 and non-Personnel Expenses - \$50,131.

Section 5. That the 26.00 additional positions referred to in Section 4 above, be and they are hereby authorized on a limited basis for the balance of Fiscal Year 1985.

Section 6. That the Building Inspection Enterprise Fund (41300) be and the same is hereby declared to be exempt from the limitations of Proposition "J" and the calculations associated therewith.



Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two (2) public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
