AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-16249 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 00-16249-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY ADDING TO THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT (110) HORSE MOUNTED PATROL ORGANIZATION 443, THREE (3) POLICE OFFICER II POSITIONS AND ONE (1) LABORER POSITION; ADDING TO THE FY 1985 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM A NEW PROJECT, CIP NO. 36-045, ENTITLED "STABLE EXPANSION;" TRANSFERRING WITHIN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT (110) THE SUM OF \$50,246 FROM CONTINGENCY RESERVE (4905) TO SALARIES AND WAGES (\$37,907) AND FRINGE BENEFITS (\$12,339); TRANSFERRING WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND 100 THE SUM OF \$112,653 FROM POLICE DEPARTMENT (110) CONTINGENCY RESERVE (4905) TO THE ALLOCATED RESERVE (901); AND TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF \$64,000 FROM THE ALLOCATED RESERVE (901) TO CIP PROJECT NO. 36-045, "STABLE EXPANSION."

WHEREAS, in September 1982, City Council authorized the formation of a Horse Mounted Patrol for the Police Department, but because facilities closer to the Downtown area could not be found, the horses were initially boarded in Lakeside; and

WHEREAS, from the start, this was not a desirable long-term boarding accommodation in terms of cost and travel time and two hours of effective patrol time was lost daily transporting the animals from Lakeside to Balboa Park; and

WHEREAS, in order to remedy this problem, a meeting of Police
Department and Park and Recreation personnel was held in early
February 1983 to discuss potential stable facility sites; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing all possible locations it was decided, for logistical and practical reasons, to use the Gold Gulch area of Balboa Park; and

WHEREAS, this concept was reviewed and approved by all appropriate boards and committees, including the Balboa Park Committee, the Park and Recreation Facilities Committee, and the Park and Recreation Board and the existing facility was subsequently completed in late June 1984 and dedicated August 9, 1984; and

WHEREAS, at the City Council meeting of July 2, 1984, \$250,000 was allocated to the Police Department for the expansion of the Horse Mounted Patrol (HMP); and

WHEREAS, with Council approval, the Police Department proposes to add three (3) Police Officer II positions and one (1) Laborer position and spend \$162,899 of the \$250,000 allocated by Council, said expenditure to represent complete funding of the stable expansion, truck, trailer, and radio equipment, miscellaneous outlay and prorated expenditure of personnel and miscellaneous nonpersonnel expense (as set forth in Attachment A hereto); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-16249 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984-85 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-16249-1, as

amended and adopted therein, by adding to the personnel authorization schedule of the Police Department (110), Horse Mounted Patrol, Organization 443, three (3.0) Police Officer II positions and one (1.0) Laborer position for the purpose of expanding the Horse Mounted Patrol function.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-16249 (New Series), as amended, cited above, be further amended by adding to the Fiscal Year 1985 Capital Improvement Program a new Project No. 36-045, entitled "Stable Expansion."

Section 3. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to transfer within the Police Department (110) the sum of \$50,246 from Contingency Reserves (4905) to the following: Salaries and Wages - \$37,907, and Fringe Benefits - \$12,339, to be used solely and exclusively for personnel costs of the positions authorized in Section 1. above.

Section 4. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to transfer within the General Fund 100, the sum of \$112, 653 from the Police Department (110) Contingency Reserve (4905) to the Allocated Reserve (901), to be directed toward Stable Expansion (\$64,000) and purchase of supplies and equipment (\$48,653) which is related to expansion of the Horse Mounted Patrol function.

Section 5. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby further authorized and directed to transfer the sum of \$64,000 [placed in Allocated Reserve (901) above in Section 4] from the Allocated Reserve (901) to CIP Project No. 36-045, "Stable Expansion," for purposes consistent with the expansion of stable requirements.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two (2) public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
