ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 16394 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON MAR 25 1985

AN ORDINANCE RECOGNIZING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WHICH ESTABLISHES A COMMUNICATION/MEDIATION PROCESS FOR MOBILEHOME OWNERS AND MOBILEHOME PARK OWNERS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That this Council hereby establishes a participation process to be known as the communication/mediation process to protect the public health, safety and welfare. This communication/mediation process shall require that mobilehome park owners and owners of mobilehomes meet-and-confer on matters of mutual interest and concerns brought to their attention in a specified manner as set forth in a written Memorandum of Understanding to be established by residents living in mobilehome parks and owners of mobilehome parks within the City of San Diego and submitted for approval by resolution of this Council.


A. The results of the use of the process established by this ordinance shall be reviewed annually by the Council of The City of San Diego at a noticed public hearing for purposes of evaluating the mediation and communication undertaken and compliance by the parties involved.

B. The provisions of this ordinance are applicable for purposes of communication/mediation and results are not binding on the parties involved.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
