AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER IX, ARTICLE 2, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 92.0100, 92.0101, 92.0201, 92.0202, 92.0502, 92.0503, 92.0506, 92.0508, 92.0510, 92.0512, 92.0627 AND 92.0628; AND BY REPEALING SECTIONS 92.0108, 92.0505, 92.0511, 92.0601, 92.0602, 92.0603 AND 92.0625; RELATING TO THE ELECTRICAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter IX, Article 2, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Sections 92.0100, 92.0101, 92.0201, 92.0202, 92.0502, 92.0503, 92.0506, 92.0508, 92.0510, 92.0512, 92.0627 and 92.0628, to read as follows:

SEC. 92.0100 SCOPE

The requirements of this Article shall apply to all privately owned electrical installations with the following exceptions:

- A. No change.
- B. Installations listed in Article 90-2(b) of the 1984 National Electrical Code.
 - C. No change.

SEC. 92.0101 STANDARDS FOR INSTALLATIONS

The National Electrical Code, 1984 Edition, published by the National Fire Protection Association,

one printed copy of which is filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 769083, be, and the same is hereby adopted as part of the Municipal Code of the City of San Diego, except as hereinafter modified, amended, repealed, or deleted; and by reference thereto is made a part hereof as though fully set out herein.

SEC. 92.0201 PERMITS REQUIRED

- A. and B. No Change.
- C. A separate permit shall be required for each building or structure which stands alone, except garages which are accessory to single-family residences and are located on the same premises.
- D. Permits for privately-owned conduits or other materials in public places and in and across streets and alleys may be issued only after approval has been granted for the installation, by the City Engineer. All work shall be done in accordance with law and special regulations applicable thereto.

SEC. 92.0202 PERMITS - EXCEPTIONS

SEC. 92.0503 POWER DISTRIBUTION PANELS

Each store and each dwelling unit shall be supplied power from its own distribution panel. Such panels shall not supply other portions of the building. A dwelling unit is a single unit providing complete, independent living facilities for one or more persons including permanent provisions for living, sleeping, eating, cooking and sanitation.

SEC. 92.0506 LABELING

- B. Meter bases shall be labeled by address to identify the occupancy served.
 - C. and D. No change.

SEC. 92.0508 TRANSFORMERS

A. Locations:

- 1. Transformers shall not be installed in ducts, plenums or other air-handling spaces.
 - 2. No change.
- 3. Transformers installed for the operation of doorbells, chimes, annunciators and similar devices, when placed in an attic or beneath a building or structure, shall be located within two feet (2') of the opening leading into the attic or beneath a building or structure.

SEC. 92.0510 USE OF NONMETALLIC CABLES

- A. Nonmetallic cables are approved only for dwelling and residential accessory occupancies not exceeding three floors in height. Dwelling occupancies include hotels, motels, apartment houses, convents, monasteries, lodging houses and one and two family houses. Residential accessory occupancies will neither exceed a total of 1,000 square feet nor exceed 700 square feet of concentrated use assembly areas such as auditoriums, chapels, meeting rooms, exercise rooms and dance floors. In mixed occupancies (commercial/dwelling) where there is a required firewall separation, the appropriate wiring method may be used on each side of the firewall. Where there is no required firewall, the most restrictive wiring method shall be used throughout the entire building.
- B. This limitation does not apply to nonmetallic cables installed in accordance with Articles 725, 760 and 800.

SEC. 92.0512 ALUMINUM CONDUCTORS AND CONDUIT

- A. An approved type of inhibitor shall be used on all non-plated stranded aluminum conductor terminations.
- B. Aluminum conductors installed underground shall be installed in an approved raceway.
- C. Aluminum grounding conductors where used outdoors or where penetrating the exterior wall shall be factory insulated.

D. Aluminum conduit, boxes or fittings shall not be used embedded in earth, concrete, plaster, or within 18 inches of the earth unless the exterior finish of the aluminum conduit, boxes or fittings is approved for the purposes.

SEC. 92.0627 CONDUCTORS FOR GENERAL WIRING

The following sections of Article 310 are deleted or amended to read as follows:

SEC. 92.0510 USE OF NONMETALLIC WERENG METHODS CABLES

A. Nonmetallic wiring methods <u>cables</u> are approved only for dwelling and residential accessory occupancies not exceeding three floors in height. Dwelling occupancies include hotels, motels, apartment houses, convents, monasteries, lodging houses and one and two family houses. Residential accessory occupancies will neither exceed a total of 1,000 square feet nor exceed 700 square feet of concentrated use assembly areas such as auditoriums, chapels, meeting rooms, exercise rooms and dance floors. In mixed occupancies (commercial/dwelling) where there is a required firewall separation, the appropriate wiring method may be used on each side of the firewall. Where there is no required firewall, the most restrictive wiring method shall be used throughout the entire building.

B. Approved nonmetallic conduit may be used in dwelling and residential accessory occupancies. In other occupancies (commercial), approved nonmetallic conduit may be used when embedded in concrete or extending no more than 40 inches inside the building before terminating in an approved metallic wiring method. This limitation does not apply to nonmetallic cables installed in accordance with Articles 725, 760 and 800.

E. By special permission nonmetablic conduit may be approved in locations subject to corresive influences.

D. By special permission nonmetallic surface extensions may be approved. The amount of plastic and the type of use shall be considered in determining approval.

ET This section does not apply to wiring, devices, appliances or equipment operating at a voltage not exceeding 25 volts between conductors and not capable of supplying more than 50 watts of energy.

SEC. 92.0512 ALUMINUM CONDUCTORS AND CONDUIT

A. Non-plated aluminum conductors installed on 15 and 20 ampere branch circuits shall not be attached directly to snap-switches, receptables, or fixtures.

B. A. An approved type of inhibitor shall be used on all non-plated stranded aluminum conductor terminations.

6. B. Aluminum conductors installed underground shall be installed in an approved raceway.

B. C. Aluminum grounding conductors where used outdoors or where penetrating the exterior wall shall be factory insulated.

ET D. Aluminum conduit, boxes or fittings shall not be used embedded in earth, concrete, plaster, or within 18 inches of the earth unless the exterior finish of the aluminum conduit, boxes or fittings is approved for the purposes.
