AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. O-15924  
(NEW SERIES) AND ORDINANCE NO. O-16003 (NEW  
SERIES) RELATING TO POLITICAL CAMPAIGN SIGNS  
IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as  
follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-15924 (New Series) adopted  
April 4, 1983, and Ordinance No. O-16003 (New Series) adopted  
July 11, 1983, both regarding the limitations on posting of  
political campaign signs in the public right-of-way and providing  
removal provisions, are hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force  
on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

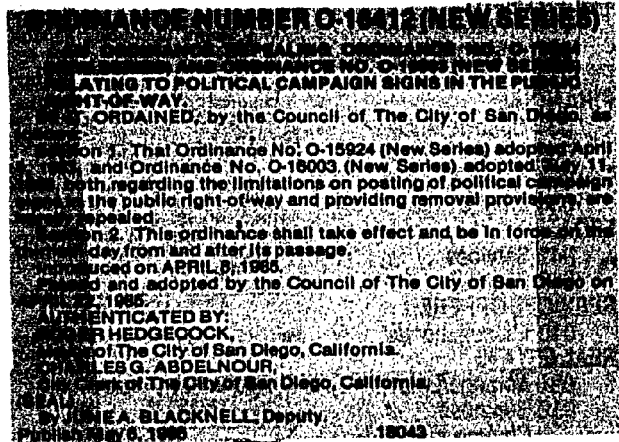
