ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 16433 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON MAY 28 1985

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING APPROXIMATELY 40.2 ACRES LOCATED NORTH OF MIRA MESA BOULEVARD, ONE-HALF MILE EAST OF THE INTERSECTION OF I-805 AND SORRENTO VALLEY ROAD, DESCRIBED AS A PORTION OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, S.B.B.M., IN THE MIRA MESA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO M-1B ZONE, AS DEFINED BY SECTION 101.0435.2 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 10936 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED OCTOBER 5, 1972, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INsofar AS THE SAME CONFLICTS HERewith.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That in the event that within three years of the effective date of this ordinance approximately 40.2 acres located north of Mira Mesa Boulevard, one-half mile east of the intersection of I-805 and Sorrento Valley Road, described as a portion of Section 4, Township 15 South, Range 3 West, S.B.B.M., in the Mira Mesa Community Plan area, in The City of San Diego, California, designated "M-1B" on Zone Map Drawing No. B-3708, is subdivided and a map or maps thereof duly submitted to the City and thereafter recorded, and within such subdivision or subdivisions provision is made for the installation of public utility services and the dedication of streets, alleys and easements for public use, the provisions of Section 101.0435.2 shall attach and become applicable to the said subdivided land, and the said subdivided land shall be incorporated into M-1B

Zone, as described and defined by Section 101.0435.2, the boundary of such zone to be as indicated on Zone Map Drawing No. B-3708, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 769157. Said zoning shall attach only to those areas included in the map as provided in this section.

Section 2. That in the event the zoning restrictions shall attach to the said land described in Section 1 of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 10936 (New Series), adopted October 5, 1972, be, and it is hereby repealed insofar as it conflicts herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, and no building permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefor was made prior to the date of adoption of this ordinance.

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 0-16434 (NEW SERIES)**  
**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1985-86.**

The ordinance establishes a schedule of compensation for the fiscal year 1985-86 to provide an approximate increase over the fiscal year 1984-85 in the following units except for those classifications specifically excepted:

UNIT	APPROXIMATE INCREASE
Administrative	4.5%
General	4.5%
Professional	4.5%
Administrative Support and Services	4.5%
Trades and Equipment Operator	4.5%
Maintenance and Labor	5.0%
Police	5.0%

The ordinance also provides an additional 3% increase, effective January 3, 1985 for all of the clerical classifications and Data Entry Operator classes in the Technical Unit.

The ordinance additionally provides for the City to contribute into the Retirement System on behalf of employees in the following amounts:

All Classified Officers and Employees and all classified employees with the exception of those classified employees in the Police and Fire Bargaining Unit	4.5%
Classified employees in the Police Bargaining Unit and Fire Bargaining Unit	6.5%

The ordinance also provides, to be effective July 5, 1985, an additional one-half of one percent (.5%) to a total of 4.5% as the employee's voluntary contribution to the Supplemental Pension Plan.

In addition, there are provided, pursuant to sections 12.1 and 12.2 of the City Charter, pay increases for the Mayor and City Council for the fiscal year 1985-86 in accordance with the recommendations of the Salary Setting Commission heretofore accepted and approved by Resolution No. R-260505, dated April 23, 1984.

The ordinance also includes excepted salary increases for certain classifications, new classifications, title changes to classifications and classification deletions.

The ordinance further establishes base work periods; establishes ranges and salary ranges for those officers and employees in classified service; and provides for: overtime and extra compensation based on unusual work periods; educational incentive; sabbatical pay; sick leave reimbursement; and exceptional performance pay.
