AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 6, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 26.05 RELATING TO THE SENIOR CITIZENS' ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, the Senior Citizens Advisory Board was created by Ordinance No. O-16097 and incorporated in The San Diego Municipal Code as section 26.05; and

WHEREAS, section 26.05B provides for the composition of the Board and specifies that the chairperson shall be selected from those members representing the City at large; and

WHEREAS, the present chairperson of the Board has indicated that the entire Board agrees that it would be much more democratic if the Board were free to select the chairperson from among all of its members; and

WHEREAS, it is now requested that said current provision relating to the selection of a chairperson be changed to permit such wider choice of selection; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 6, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by amending section 26.05B to read as follows:

SEC. 26.05 SAN DIEGO SENIOR CITIZENS' ADVISORY BOARD No change in subsection A.

B. SENIOR CITIZENS' ADVISORY BOARD ESTABLISHED

There is hereby established a Senior Citizens'
Advisory Board consisting of eleven (11) members
who shall serve without compensation. The Board
shall include one (1) representative from each
Council District and three (3) members representing
the City at large.

The members shall serve for a two-year term and each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The Mayor shall make such appointments pursuant to Council policy. The members shall be appointed in such a manner so that the terms of not more than six (6) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date of all terms shall be July 1. The Board shall select from among its members a chairperson to serve as such for a one-year term.

The Board shall meet not less than once every three (3) months and present a report to the Mayor and Council on a semi-annual basis. The Mayor shall appoint one member of the Council to serve as liaison to the Board and one other member of the Council as an alternate.

The Board shall adopt rules consistent with the law for the government of its business and procedures.

Section 2. All remaining provisions of section 26.05 shall remain unchanged.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
