ADOPTED ON SEP 9 1980

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 3 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 63.25.73 RELATED TO THE LEAVING OF VESSELS, BOATS AND TRAILERS OVERNIGHT ON THE BEACHES OF MISSION BAY PARK.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding Section 63.25.73 thereto to read as follows:

SEC. 63.25.73 OVERNIGHT STORAGE OF VESSELS, BOATS AND TRAILERS PROHIBITED

(a) No person shall store or leave any vessel, boat or trailer on the beach on the west shoreline of Mission Bay Park between Santa Clara Point north to Yarmouth Court between the hours of 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., except where permitted by the Park and Recreation Director at an authorized beach mooring bar. This prohibition shall not apply between 10:00 p.m. Friday night through 7:00 a.m. Sunday morning, nor from 10:00 p.m. of the night preceding an official holiday of the City of San Diego through 7:00 a.m. on the day of the holiday.

(b) The Park and Recreation Director may without notice remove any vessel, boat or trailer stored or left in violation of Section 63.25.73(a) and the cost of removal and storage may be recovered by the City against any person responsible therefor through collection processes or proceedings in any court of competent jurisdiction.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
