AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 8760 AND ORDINANCE NO. 10955 (NEW SERIES) AND ORDINANCE NO. 12462 (NEW SERIES), RELATING TO THE GRANTING OF A NON-EXCLUSIVE PIPELINE FRANCHISE TO SAN DIEGO PIPELINE COMPANY FOR A PERIOD OF FORTY YEARS TO INSTALL, CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE A PIPELINE FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS AND OTHER HYDROCARBON SUBSTANCES IN CERTAIN CITY STREETS OF AND WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, San Diego Pipeline Company (SDPC) was awarded a franchise by The City of San Diego on November 27, 1962, for forty (40) years, which covers approximately 11.6 miles of fuel pipeline facilities in public streets, and as amended by Ordinance No. 10955 (New Series), on November 21, 1972, which covers approximately 195 feet in relocation, and as amended by Ordinance No. 12462 (New Series) required by the City's vacation of a portion of Kearny Villa Road and SDPC's consequent relocation into the new alignment of Kearny Villa Road and Aero Drive; and

WHEREAS, due to the existing pipeline system's insufficient capacity to deliver adequate quantities of refined petroleum products and other hydrocarbon substances to an expanding market, it is necessary to construct an additional pipeline, 16-inch in diameter, and it is necessary in order to construct said pipeline that an addition to the franchise area is required; and

WHEREAS, the addition to the franchise will consist of the crossings of streets and/or roads of and within the City of San

Diego, listed hereafter, within the general pipeline route as identified in Exhibit I to this amendment, attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the following streets and/or roads within the boundaries of The City of San Diego will be crossed: Via De La Valle, El Camino Real, Black Mountain Road, Carmel Valley Road, El Camino Real (a second crossing), Sorrento Valley Boulevard, Lusk Boulevard, Water Ridge Circle, Water Ridge Vista Drive, Mira Mesa Boulevard, Carrol Canyon Road, Eastgate Mall Road and Miramar Road, said points of crossing as described in Exhibit I, attached hereto, with the length of the pipeline within these streets and/or roads being approximately 1300 feet; and

WHEREAS, annual compensation for this additional pipeline will be computed as presented in Section 22 of Ordinance 8760; and

WHEREAS, all costs relating to the construction will be borne by the San Diego Pipeline Company, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 8760 and Ordinance No. 10955 (New Series) and Ordinance No. 12462 (New Series), be and are hereby amended by adding to Appendix A thereto the legal description attached hereto as Exhibit I to incorporate within the franchise area the crossings of those certain streets and/or roads of and within the City of San Diego within the legal description as set forth in said Exhibit I.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

EXHIBIT I

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

SAN DIEGO PIPELINE COMPANY

The following is a general description of the proposed San Diego Pipeline Company (SDPC) 16-inch pipeline route in The City of San Diego. It should be noted that in part the distances and bearings have been scaled and therefore are approximate.

The route of the pipeline in The City of San Diego will parallel the existing 10-inch SDPC pipeline, as previously described in Appendix A of Ordinance 8760 and in Exhibit I of Ordinance No. 10955 (New Series) and Ordinance No. 12462 (New Series), from its entrance into the City north of Via De La Valle to its termination at the Miramar Naval Air Station east of Interstate Highway 805 and State Highway 52, except in Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 3 West, where the pipeline will be located upon the existing San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E) easement, said easement in a northwesterly to southeasterly alignment with the existing 10-inch pipeline location both northwesterly in Section 32, Township 14 South, Range 3 West, and southeasterly in Section 5, Township 15 South, Range 3 West.
