

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 16514 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON NOV 18 1985

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 7, DIVISION 20, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 27.2004 RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS AND SECTION 27.2005 RELATING TO THE CALLING OF ELECTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 7, Division 20, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 27.2004 to read as follows:

SEC. 27.2004 CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS-
INCORPORATION OF STATE LAW

(a) All elections shall be conducted by the Clerk, except that elections for members of the governing boards of the San Diego Unified School District and Community College District held in even-numbered years on the same day as the statewide primary and general election shall, pursuant to Education Code Section 5303, be conducted by the Registrar.

(b) All elections shall be conducted under the election laws of the State of California except as specifically provided by the Charter or this Article.

Section 2. That Chapter II, Article 7, Division 20 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 27.2005 to read as follows:


SEC. 27.2005 CALLING OF ELECTIONS

The Council shall by ordinance call all elections and shall specify the purpose or purposes and the time of such election, except for elections for members of the governing board of the San Diego Unified School District and Community College District held in even-numbered years on the same day as the statewide primary and general elections.

Section 3. This ordinance relating as it does to elections shall take effect and be in force on the day of its introduction and adoption pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter.
