AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 3, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING DIVISION 9 SECTION 33.0905 RELATING TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF AUTO WRECKAGE REGULATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding Division 9, Section 33.0905 relating to the enforcement of autowreckage regulations.

SEC. 33.0905 ENFORCEMENT

Any employee designated by the Chief of Police with the duty to enforce the provisions of this Division is hereby authorized to arrest any person without a warrant whenever said employee has reasonable cause to believe that the person to be arrested has committed a violation of this Division in his presence.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


