ADOPTED ON OCT 14 1985

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2,
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING
SECTION 22.1901 RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS.

WHEREAS, at the June 10, 1985 meeting of the Rules Committee, Ms. Gertrude Evans questioned the role of the Housing Commission in lobbying for State and Federal legislation without City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee directed the City Manager, City Attorney and Director of Intergovernmental Relations to report back to the Rules Committee on the relationship between various City corporations' and agencies' lobbying efforts and the City Council role in providing oversight in that area; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney provided to the IRD Director, by memorandum dated July 3, 1985, the conclusion that City corporations and agencies are vested with discretionary powers and function as specified in the enabling instruments creating them but if the City Council created the entity or contracts with them, then the City Council may provide direction as to whether the entity involved may or may not take positions on legislation and under what circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Relations Department (IRD), in its Report No. 85078, dated July 3, 1985, set forth the discussion and background underlying responsibility for

conducting and presenting recommendations on legislation affecting the City; and

WHEREAS, the Director of IRD recommended that the San Diego Municipal Code section 22.1901 be amended to provide that said department be vested with the responsibility and authority to conduct legislative lobbying efforts after receiving Rules Committee and City Council concurrence, specifically as it pertains to entities organized or created by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee considered and discussed IRD Report No. 85-78 at its July 8, 1985 meeting and voted unanimously to adopt the IRD recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee further agreed to direct the City Attorney to return to the Rules Committee on August 12, 1985 with a draft ordinance reflecting said appropriate amendment to Municipal Code section 22.1091 and to provide new language from time to time to change agreements with City created corporations and organizations to reflect and incorporate such change; and

WHEREAS, it is now deemed appropriate to amend section 22.1901 of the San Diego Municipal Code to incorporate the changes recommended in IRD Report No. 85-75, dated July 3, 1985; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending section 22.1901 to read as follows:

SEC. 22.1901 DEPARTMENT OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS

A. The Department of Intergovernmental Relations is a City department. The Director is the administrative head of the department and shall be appointed by and may be removed by a majority of the Council. The Director shall, under direction of the Council Committee on Rules, Legislation and Intergovernmental Relations, be responsible for planning, recommending, coordinating and administering a State and Federal legislative program for The City of San Diego. The department shall provide legislative coordination and liaison under direction of the Council Committee on Rules, Legislation and Intergovernmental Relations and, in consultation with City departments, City organized or created entities, and other sources:

(1) Develop for City Council approval City legislative programs for the State and Federal legislative sessions.

(2) Represent the City before State and Federal legislative and administrative bodies.

(3) Analyze and submit reports on State and Federal legislation affecting the City.

(4) Maintain liaison with and assist the City's State and Federal legislative delegations in any matter of interest to the City.

(5) Initiate and assist other City departments and City organized or created entities in identifying, seeking and receiving Federal and State grants and

coordinate through legislative advocacy those grant efforts.

(6) Represent city via appropriate endeavors in identifying, seeking and receiving endowments and related gifts of funds, buildings and facilities.


(7) Perform related work as directed.

B. It is the intent of the City Council that the Department of Intergovernmental Relations shall serve and perform as the City's liaison and coordinating clearinghouse for all State and Federal legislative activity, under the direction of the Council Committee on Rules, Legislation and Intergovernmental Relations for City government, City organized or created entities and such other organizations as may, from time-to-time, be related to and involved with City operations, to include but not be limited to contractual relationships providing for direction and control in respect to legislative activities.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

This ordinance amends the San Diego Municipal Code section
22.1901 which establishes the Department of Intergovernmental
Relations and sets forth its duties and responsibilities. The ordinance
adds to section 22.1901 a provision that corporations, commissions
and agencies created by the City shall be required to report
through the Department of Intergovernmental Relations
engaging in any activity connected with legislative advocacy.
The Department of Intergovernmental Relations is further declared to
be the central clearinghouse for all such legislative advocacy and
under the control and guidance of the Rules Committee for
departments and City created corporations, entities and agencies.
