ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 16588 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON DEC 17 1985

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 25, 1986.

WHEREAS, Roger Hedgecock, Mayor of The City of San Diego, has resigned the Office of Mayor of The City of San Diego, thereby creating a vacancy in the office of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Charter of The City of San Diego provides that in the event of a vacancy occurring in the office of the Mayor the Council shall have authority to fill such vacancy by appointment, but in the event the Council shall fail to fill such vacancy by appointment within thirty (30) days after the vacancy, the Council must immediately cause an election to be held to fill such vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on December 16, 1985 adopted Resolution No. R-264751, declaring its intention to call Special Municipal Elections to be held on February 25, 1986 and, if needed, on June 3, 1986, to be consolidated with the Statewide Primary election, to fill said vacancy by election; and

WHEREAS, the Charter provides that at said election a person shall be elected to serve for the remainder of such unexpired term; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Special Municipal Election will be held in The City of San Diego on Tuesday, February 25, 1986, for the purpose of electing a Mayor to fill the unexpired term of Roger Hedgecock.

Section 2. For the purpose of said election, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain of said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list of consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall designate the polling places, and shall appoint the members of the precinct boards for said elections.

Section 4. That the polls for said elections shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, February 25, 1986.

Section 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to procure and supply the required number of ballots, sample ballots, equipment, supplies and other printed matter.

Section 6. The following rates of compensation are hereby established for said election:

Inspectors	\$50.00*
Judges and Clerks	\$35.00
Rental of Polling Place	\$25.00

*Compensation amount provides for ballot bag returns.

Section 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of The City of San Diego.

Section 8. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.

WHEREAS, Roger Hedgecock, Mayor of The City of San Diego, has resigned the Office of Mayor of The City of San Diego, thereby creating a vacancy in the office of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Charter of The City of San Diego provides that in the event of a vacancy occurring in the office of the Mayor the Council shall have authority to fill such vacancy by appointment; but in the event the Council shall fail to fill such vacancy by appointment within forty (40) days after the vacancy, the Council must immediately cause an election to be held to fill such vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on December 16, 1985 adopted Resolution No. R-264751, declaring its intention to call Special Municipal Elections to be held on February 25, 1986 and, if needed, on June 3, 1986, to be consolidated with the Statewide Primary election, to fill said vacancy by election; and

WHEREAS, the Charter provides that at said election a person shall be elected to serve for the remainder of such unexpired term;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Special Municipal Election will be held in The City of San Diego on Tuesday, February 25, 1986, for the purpose of electing a Mayor to fill the unexpired term of Roger Hedgecock.

Section 2. For the purpose of said election, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain of said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list of consolidation proposals on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall designate the polling places, and shall appoint the members of the precinct boards for said elections.

Section 4. That the polls for said elections shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, February 25, 1986.

Section 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to procure and supply the required number of ballots, sample ballots, equipment, supplies and other printed matter.

Section 6. The following rates of compensation are hereby established for said election:

Rental of Polling Place	\$25.00
