WHEREAS, on January 12, 1985, the Homeport San Diego Festival will commemorate San Diego becoming a homeport to three cruise lines and a port of call to four others; and

WHEREAS, The Homeport San Diego Festival also will salute the Navy and maritime fleets already homeported in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, during the festival, three cruise ships--the <u>Pacific</u>

<u>Princess</u>, the <u>Viking Princess</u>, and the <u>Azure Seas</u>--will be in San

<u>Diego;</u> and

WHEREAS, <u>Pacific Princess</u>, television's famed "Love Boat," operated by Princess Cruises, will begin on January 12 a season of voyages from its new San Diego homeport to the Mexican Riviera; and

WHEREAS, <u>Viking Princess</u> of the Crown Cruise Line will leave the same day on one of its day cruises to Ensenada, which have helped this City establish its identity as a cruise ship homeport; and

WHEREAS, <u>Azure Seas</u> will begin later in the month the third season of weekly Los Angeles-San Diego-Ensenada voyages for Western Cruise Lines; and

WHEREAS, <u>Pacific Northwest Explorer</u> has begun a homeported schedule from San Diego to the Sea of Cortez and a second ship, <u>North Star</u>, will be scheduled by Exploration Cruise Lines for additional San Diego-Gulf of California cruises later in the year; and

WHEREAS, Costa Cruises will bring its ship, <u>Daphne</u>, back to San Diego in 1985 during a transcanal voyage; and

WHEREAS, American Hawaii Cruises has scheduled a transpacific voyage from Hawaii to San Diego by the Constitution; and

WHEREAS, Holland America Line has scheduled a call later in the year in San Diego for the Canada-bound Rotterdam; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that January, 1985, is declared HOMEPORT SAN DIEGO MONTH in recognition of San Diego's growing stature as a homeport through the partnership of the cruise lines and the San Diego Cruise Industry Consortium.
