## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 262619 ADOPTED ON FEB 26 1985

WHEREAS, at the Planning Commission hearing on January 17, 1985, the Planning Commission of the City of San Diego voted 6 to 0 to approve TM-82-0433.1, subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 1985, pursuant to the provisions of Section 102.0308 of the San Diego Municipal Code, TOM and CYNDY HEATH, et al, appealed the decision of the Planning Commission in approving the proposed Tentative Map for Carmel Valley Neighborhood Unit 5, located on the north side of Carmel Valley Road, east of El Camino Real and south of Black Mountain Road, in the SF-2 and SF-3 Zones of the North City West Community Plan area, further described as Parcels 11-35 of Parcel Map 12871, Parcel 1 of Parcel Map 11916, Parcel 1 of Map 11917 and a portion of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 20 and a portion of the northwest quarter of Section 20, Township 14 South, Range 3 West, S.B.B.M.; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on February 26, 1985, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in considering said appeal is empowered by the provisions of Municipal Code Section 102.0308 to affirm, reverse or modify in whole or in part any determination of the Planning Commission subject to the limitations as are

placed upon the Planning Commission by the Municipal Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Council adopts the findings of the Planning Commission as follows:

- 1. The proposed map is consistent with the General Plan and North City West Community Plan which designate the property for residential and school use.
- 2. The design and proposed improvements for the subdivision are consistent with the General Plan, North City West Community Plan, SF-2, SF-3 and EP Zoning/Development Regulations and State Map Act Section 66473.1 regarding solar access.
- 3. The site is physically suitable for residential development.
- 4. The site is suitable for the proposed residential density of development, i.e., the development conforms with the minimum lot sizes of the SF-2 and SF-3 Zones..
- 5. The design of the subdivision and the proposed improvements will not cause substantial environmental damage, based upon the findings of the Environmental Report EQD No. 81-12-12 EIR.
- 6. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements will not likely cause serious public health problems inasmuch as the map is consistent with SF-2, SF-3 and EP zoning and conforms with City development regulations.
- 7. The design of the subdivision and the type of improvements are such that they will not conflict with any

easements, acquired by the public at large, for access through or use of property within the proposed subdivision.

8. That said findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appeal of TOM and CYNDY HEATH, et al, is denied; the decision of the Planning Commission to grant Tentative Map No. 82-0433.1 is sustained and said Tentative Map is hereby granted subject to conditions 1 through 31 of Planning Commission Resolution No. 5405, revised February 5, 1985 and filed in the office of the City Clerk.
