WHEREAS, Councilmember William Jones, by memorandum dated December 6, 1984, proposed the establishment of a 1985 City of San Diego Campaign Review Committee; and

WHEREAS, said Committee establishment would be pursuant to Charter section 43(b), for the purpose of addressing issues set forth in the above-mentioned December 6, 1984 memorandum and for that period of time which is sufficient to complete the objectives for which the Committee was established; and

WHEREAS, the proposal for this temporary advisory committee came before the Committee on Rules, Legislation and Intergovernmental Affairs at its regularly scheduled meeting of February 11, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee reviewed the proposal to establish the Charter section 43(b) Campaign Review Committee, deciding upon a membership of twelve (12) people to be appointed pursuant to the provisions of Council Policy 000-13, and approved the matter by a unanimous (5-0) vote; and

WHEREAS, the matter is now forwarded to the full Council for approval and action as recommended; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that pursuant to Charter section 43(b), there is hereby created a Campaign Review Committee, consisting of the following eighteen (18) members for the purpose of addressing issues set forth in

Councilmember William Jones' memorandum to the Mayor and City Council, dated December 6, 1984 and City policies related thereto, which, by this reference, are hereby adopted:
