RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 262832

ADOPTED ON APR 08 1985

WHEREAS, California is entering a period of increased seismic activity with more earthquakes occurring in the past two years above Richter magnitude 6 than in the previous two decades; and

WHEREAS, there is a possibility that our city and county could experience a damaging earthquake in the future, because past earthquakes demonstrate that all of California should be considered "earthquake country;" and

WHEREAS, the residents of our city and county frequently travel through or visit areas of the state which are likely to experience earthquakes of damaging intensities at some time in the future; and

WHEREAS, emergency preparedness measures taken by a community before, during and after a damaging earthquake can reduce loss of life and property, ease fears and lessen confusion; and

WHEREAS, with the assistance of the Governor's Office of Emergency Services, volunteer agencies, private businesses, and the federal government, the San Diego Office of Emergency Services will attempt to inform and educate San Diego residents about earthquake preparedness; NOW THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the entire city, does hereby declare the week of April 15 through 20, 1985 to be Earthquake Preparedness Week, and all residents are urged to

learn what to do before, during and after an earthquake to prevent injuries, loss of life and property damage; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego will provide its residents, including school children and disabled, appropriate earthquake safety information, not only during this special week, but throughout the year.
