WHEREAS, in August 1984, the City Council directed the Rules Committee to review, hold public hearings and make recommendations as necessary on revisions to the draft "Arts Plan for The City of San Diego" proposed by COMBO; and

WHEREAS, in November 1984, the Council approved a work program outlining the steps the Rules Committee and staff should follow in reviewing and revising the draft Arts Plan; and

WHEREAS, the first step in this work plan was a review and update of the art and cultural needs of the City outlined in COMBO's draft Arts Plan; and

WHEREAS, this step was also to include a prioritization of the needs, as the COMBO draft plan had not provided any ranking of the relative importance of the needs; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Relations Department, in its Report No. 85-25, dated March 5, 1985, to the Rules Committee, identified and set forth eleven (11) art and cultural needs in a prioritized needs order; and

WHEREAS, said prioritized art and cultural needs as set forth in IRD Report No. 85-25, was reviewed and approved by the Rules Committee on March 11, 1984 with a unanimous (5-0) vote; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee now forwards the matter to the full Council for action, with a recommendation to adopt; NOW, THEREFORE,
