ADOPTED ON APR 08 1985

WHEREAS, a proliferation of residential care and substance abuse treatment facilities has emerged within the "Greater Golden Hill Community" as depicted on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the California State Department of Social Services licenses residential care facilities in accordance with the California Health and Safety Code and the California State Department of Substance Abuse and various other recovery/assistance facilities; and

WHEREAS, the "Greater Golden Hill Community" represents 1.5 percent of the population of the City of San Diego yet has 10.3 percent of the total residential care and substance abuse treatment facilities within the City, excluding child care, elderly housing and foster home facilities; and

WHEREAS, this overconcentration of residential care and substance abuse treatment facilities hinders the implementation of the "Greater Golden Hill Precise Plan" as the adopted General Plan of this community by having such a disproportionate share of the overall uses; and

WHEREAS, these residential care and substance abuse treatment facilities, except for child care facilities, foster family homes and housing for the elderly have impaired the integrity of residential neighborhoods by not balancing residential care

facilities throughout the City and concentrating the facilities in the "Greater Golden Hill Community;" NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

- 1. That the "Greater Golden Hill Community" is adversely impacted by an overconcentration of residential care and substance abuse treatment facilities, other than child care facilities, foster family homes and housing for the elderly.
- 2. That the implementation of the "Greater Golden Hill Precise Plan" will be impaired and the integrity of residential neighborhoods compromised by the further development of residential care or substance abuse treatment facilities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego that the California State Departments of Social Services and Substance Abuse are to be notified of this overconcentration and the appropriate City of San Diego administrative departments are to inform the California State Departments of Social Services and Substance Abuse of this each time an application is submitted for comment relating to the "Greater Golden Hill Community" as illustrated on Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.


