BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to file a preapplication, substantially in the form of the copy on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.

 262863, with the State Department of Commerce for designation of portions of the City of San Diego San Ysidro Community area as an enterprise zone (application area) in accordance with the procedures and regulations promulgated by the State Department of Commerce under the Employment and Economic Incentives Act (AB 514).
- 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to designate the street boundaries of the High Density Unemployment Area (HDUA) as follows:

Starting at the intersection of Dairy Mart Road and Beyer Boulevard, then east along Beyer Boulevard to I-805, then south on I-805 to the United States Mexico Border, then west along the United States Mexico Border to Dairy Mart Road, then north along Dairy Mart Road to its intersection with Beyer Boulevard, the point of origination.

3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to designate the street boundaries of the Neighborhood Economic Development Area (NED) as the same as for the HDUA.

4. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to endorse the preliminary application which contains a Targeted Economic Development Area (TED) with the following street boundaries:

Starting at the intersection of Dairy Mart Road and Beyer Boulevard, then east on Beyer Boulevard to I-805, then north on I-805 to SR-117, then west on SR-117 to Beyer Boulevard, then north on Beyer Boulevard to Coronado Avenue, then west on Coronado Avenue to I-5, then south on I-5 to Dairy Mart Road, then north on Dairy Mart Road to Beyer Boulevard, the point of origination.

Further declaring that the TED is within the City of San Diego and also within close geographic proximity to the proposed HDUA.

- 5. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to direct the necessary development plan processing by both the City's Engineering and Development Department and Planning Department, and building permit issuance by the City's Building Inspection Department be fast tracked for commercial and industrial businesses within such a zone if approved by the State of California.
- 6. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to direct that the development plan processing fees normally collected by the City's Engineering and Development Department, Planning Department and Building Inspection Department be waived for commercial and industrial businesses within such a zone if approved by the State of California.
