WHEREAS, SHELL OIL COMPANY, a Delaware corporation,

Owner/Permittee, filed an application to amend Conditional Use

Permit No. 10-643-0 to permit replacing a cashier's booth with a

mini-market at an existing self-serve gasoline station located at

the southeast corner of Navajo Road and Jackson Drive, known as

6953 Navajo Road, further described as Lot 398 of Lakeshore Unit

No. 5, Map No. 5178, in the CA Zone of the Navajo Community Plan

area; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 1984, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego made its findings of fact, approved Conditional Use Permit No. 84-0532 amending CUP 10-643-0 and filed said decision in the office of the City Clerk on November 30, 1984; and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 1984, pursuant to the provisions of Section 101.0506 of the San Diego Municipal Code, NAVAJO COMMUNITY PLANNERS, by Ann W. MacCullough, appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on January 8, 1985, continued to April 9, 1985, and testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

All of the following facts exist with respect to Conditional Use Permit No. 84-0532:

- 1. The proposed use would adversely affect the neighborhood and would be detrimental to the health, safety and general welfare of persons residing in the area. This Council believes that the addition of the mini-market and expanded operation of this development at this location would be incompatible with adjacent uses and with the neighborhood.
- 2. The proposed use would not comply with all relevant regulations in the Municipal Code. This Council does not believe that appropriate conditions exist to approve the amendment.

The above findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council does hereby grant the appeal of NAVAJO COMMUNITY PLANNERS, by Ann W. MacCullough, overrules the decision of the Planning Commission and does hereby deny to SHELL OIL COMPANY, Owner/Permittee, Conditional Use Permit No. 84-0532.
