WHEREAS, on April 22, 1985, the Rules Committee accepted City Manager Report No. 85-202 which discussed the impact of proposed federal budget reductions on the City and its various agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee further directed the City Manager to report back in one month regarding priorities which should be followed by the City's legislative advocates in Washington, D. C. in attempting to influence the final form of the federal budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager complied with said direction to provide recommendations regarding such priorities in his Report No. 85-238, dated May 9, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee, at its regularly scheduled meeting of May 13, 1985, reviewed and discussed the information and recommendations contained in said City Manager Report No. 85-238 and approved the actions recommended therein unanimously; and


WHEREAS, the matter is now forwarded to the full Council with a recommendation to approve the legislative priority set forth in said report with a slight modification regarding Summer Youth Employment Programs and Historic Preservation Rehabilitation Tax Credits; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of said City, does hereby approve and adopt the legislative priority set forth in City Manager Report No. 85-238, dated May 9, 1985 with the modification that Summer Youth Employment Programs and Historic Preservation Rehabilitation Tax Credits be added to the First Priority Group.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of Intergovernmental Relations and the City's legislative advocates in Washington, D. C. be and they are hereby directed to take all necessary and appropriate actions to observe and follow the legislative priorities as adopted herein.
