WHEREAS, Senator Mello has introduced SB 646 which would appropriate \$1.5 million to establish the Local Arts Education Partnership Program for the purpose of allocating grants to local arts agencies to implement arts education programs in the schools similar to the earlier program; and

WHEREAS, on June 10, 1985, the Rules Committee reviewed IRD Report No. 85-60 which recommended that the City Council support SB 646 if it is amended to make local funding for future years of the program subject to appropriation by the City Council and to remove the limitation on the percentage of local funds which must come from a business, corporation, foundation, individual or nonprofit group; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee approved said recommendation unanimously (5-0 vote) and now forwards the matter to the full Council for necessary action; NOW, THEREFORE,
