RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 263669 ADOPTED ON JUL 15 1985

WHEREAS, Section 8330, et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of streets by City Council resolution where the portion of street to be vacated consists of a portion of a street or highway that lies within property under one ownership and that does not continue through such ownership or end touching property of another; and

WHEREAS, in connection with said vacation, the City desires to reserve certain easements; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the vacation of Cottonwood Road, adjacent to Lots A44, A52, and A53 and a portion of National City and Otay Railroad right-of-way vacated and Landers Road closed and vacated in Little Landers Subdivision of San Ysidro, Map 1174, to facilitate development of their property; and

WHEREAS, the portion of street to be vacated is not needed for present or prospective public street purposes; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the street to be vacated through will continue to have access; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

WHEREAS, the vacation is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That Cottonwood Road, adjacent to Lots A44, A52, and A53 and a portion of National City and Otay Railroad right-of-way vacated and Landers Road closed and vacated in Little Landers Subdivision of San Ysidro, Map 1174, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 15969-B, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-263669, which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.
- That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, easement, and privilege of placing, constructing, repairing, replacing, maintaining, using, and operating public utilities of any kind or nature, including, but not limited to, general utilities and all necessary and proper fixtures and equipment for use in connection therewith, through, over, under, upon, along, and across the hereinafter-described easement, together with the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom, together with the right to maintain the said easement free and clear of any excavation or fills, the erection or construction of any building or other structures, the planting of any tree or trees thereon, or the drilling or digging of any well or wells thereon, together with the right to otherwise protect from all hazards the operation and use of any right hereby reserved. Upon acquisition of encroachment permit from the City Engineer pursuant to the Municipal Code of the City, the owners of the underlying fee may utilize the above-described parcel of land for

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structures, the planting or growing of trees, or the installation of privately owned pipelines.

- 3. That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, from vacation and abandonment, easements, and rights of any public utility pursuant to any existing franchise or renewals thereof, at any time, or from time to time, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew, and enlarge overhead or underground lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles, and other structures, equipment, and fixtures for the transportation and distribution of electrical or electronic energy and natural gas, and for incidental purposes including access to protect the property from all hazards in, upon, over, and across the above-described portions of streets to be vacated and abandoned.
- 4. That the easement reserved herein is in, under, over, upon, along, and across that portion of Cottonwood Road, vacated by this document and as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 15969-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-263669.
- 5. That the resolution shall not become effective unless and until Parcel Maps T.M. 82-0513 and T.M. 84-0905 have been approved by the City Engineer. In the event that the final maps are not approved by March 10, 1989, this resolution shall become void and of no further force or effect.
- 6. That the City Engineer shall advise the City Clerk of the approval of the aforementioned parcel maps and that the City Clerk shall then cause a certified copy of this resolution, with

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drawing, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.


