WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, on June 11, 1985, approved the creation of a joint City/County Task Force on Human Care Needs to determine the status of human care services in The City of San Diego, identify sources of funding and other resources to meet those needs, and to make recommendations to the City and County for long-term measures to meet expected human care needs; and

WHEREAS, it is also recommended that the joint City/County
Task Force on Human Care needs:

- 1. Jointly determine the extent of human care needs in the region.
- 2. Jointly determine regional priorities for funding by geographic areas and population groups, while providing flexibility for each organization to establish its own funding priorities as well.
- 3. Jointly develop common programmatic, administrative and fiscal evaluation and monitoring processes.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors now seeks The City of San Diego's participation on this task force by appointing two (2) members of the City Council to said task force and by providing half of the staffing needs for the effort; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the task force will, no later than December 31, 1985, make its final report to the City Council and Board of Supervisors; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of said City, hereby approves participation with the County of San Diego in the City/County Task Force on Human Care Needs for the purposes set forth in the recitals above and within the time parameters indicated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Councilmembers William Jones and Gloria McColl be and they are hereby designated as the representatives of The City of San Diego to said Task Force.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be and he is hereby directed to provide the necessary City share of staff support for the Task Force, to include primarily, if so determined, an outside consultant who can provide an objective and broader perspective, with knowledge of how such issues are being dealt within other jurisdictions.
