A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE TAYLOR STREET (PACIFIC HIGHWAY TO PRESIDIO DRIVE) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R-263556, a public hearing was called for on JUL301985 at the hour of 10:00 A in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within that certain area of the City of San Diego more particularly described as follows:

Lots A through F and Lot I of MAP 1507, the easterly 80 feet of Lot 2, all of Lots 3 and 4 in Block 394, the northerly 100 feet of Lot 3 between a line parallel to and 100 feet west of the westerly line of Taylor Street and the westerly line of Taylor Street in Block 395, Lots 3 and 4 in Block 396, Lots 3 and 4 in Block 397, the northerly 20 feet of Block 398, Lots 1 and 2 in Block 409, all on OLD SAN DIEGO MISCELLANEOUS MAPS 35 and 40.

Said district shall also include the following described public rights-of-way:

TAYLOR STREET between a line parallel to and 125 feet east of the easterly line of Pacific Highway and a line parallel to and 20 feet west of the westerly line of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad right-of-way; TAYLOR STREET between the northerly line of San Diego Avenue and a line parallel to and 25 feet north of the northely line of Presidio Avenue; PRESIDIO DRIVE between the easterly line of Taylor Street and a line parallel to and 275 feet east of the easterly line of Taylor Street; WHITMAN STREET between the easterly line of Taylor Street and a line parallel to and 150 feet east of the easterly line of Taylor Street; JUAN STREET between a line parallel to and 100 feet west of the westerly line of Taylor Street, and a line parallel to and 220 feet east of the easterly line of Taylor Street; CALHOUN STREET between the easterly line of Taylor Street and a line parallel to and 220 feet east of the easterly line of Taylor Street; all as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 22104-D entitled "TAYLOR STREET (PACIFIC HIGHWAY TO PRESIDIO DRIVE) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT, " copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 20350 and attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,

R - **263773** 00797 BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.
- 2. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date upon which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.
- 3. The City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code

of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service they shall provide at their own expense all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution) and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.
