WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is the home of the Padres baseball team, the 1984 National League Champions; and

WHEREAS, in the event of a major league baseball players strike, the City of San Diego will lose more than \$1 million in revenues from San Diego Jack Murphy Stadium; and


WHEREAS, such a strike will deprive a total of 1,045 people of employment and a total of \$47,300 in wages per game; and

WHEREAS, this players' strike would result in a net revenue loss to the City of San Diego of an estimated \$32,000 per game; and

WHEREAS, there are 31 event days between Tuesday, August 6, 1985, the strike deadline set by the baseball players' union for contract agreement, and the Padres' last regular season home game is October 6, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the potential loss to the City of San Diego for 31 games totals more than \$1 million, not including any playoff and World Series games; and

WHEREAS, such a potential loss in revenue to the City of San Diego is of great concern to the taxpayers of this City; NOW, THEREFORE,



BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby expresses deep concern about the threat of a baseball players' strike and urges a speedy contract agreement resolution with the baseball players' union to avoid the cancellation of any 1985 season games.
