WHEREAS, the City Charter of The City of San Diego requires that the primary election in each odd numbered year be held on the third Tuesday in September; and

WHEREAS, in 1985, that day falls upon the second day of Rosh Hashanah, a holy day of great significance to the Jewish community; and

WHEREAS, the religious and moral convictions of some members of the Jewish community may prevent them from going to the polls because of the Jewish holy days; and

WHEREAS, there are provisions under the law for absentee voting which would enable persons of the Jewish faith to exercise their right to vote while, at the same time, observing their holy day; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Clerk be and he is hereby directed to communicate with all known Jewish religious, civic, and other organizations informing them of the procedures for absentee balloting so that they may disseminate these to their members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk be and he is hereby directed to place an advertisement in the local Jewish newspaper explaining these procedures so that the maximum number

of Jewish voters will become aware of their opportunity to vote using an absentee ballot.
