RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF MULTIFAMILY HOUSING REVENUE BONDS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR A MULTIFAMILY RENTAL HOUSING DEVELOPMENT KNOWN AS LA JOLLA DEL SOL APARTMENTS AND CERTAIN OTHER ACTIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, this City Council of The City of San Diego (the "City") has previously determined to assist La Jolla del Sol Associates, an Illinois limited partnership (the "Owner"), by providing moneys to lend to the Owner to finance the construction of a multifamily rental housing development to be located east of Lebon Drive and west of Regents Road in the City of San Diego, to be occupied in part by persons of low or moderate income, and to be known as La Jolla del Sol Apartments (the "Project"), all pursuant to its Resolution No. R-262599 of the City Council adopted on February 25, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego (the "Authority"), by its Resolution No. 00376, adopted on August 5, 1985, has determined to proceed with the issuance of revenue bonds to finance the Project in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$25,000,000 (the "Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 103(k) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended (the "Code"), the Bonds are required to be approved, following a public hearing, by an elected

representative of the issuer of the Bonds and an elected representative of the governmental unit having jurisdiction over the area in which the Project is located; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is made up of the members of the City Council, which members have been appointed but not elected to their position as Commissioners of the Authority and the City is the next higher governmental unit with an applicable elected representative from which the Authority derives its authority; and

WHEREAS, the Project will be located wholly within the geographic jurisdiction of the City; and

WHEREAS, this City Council is the elected legislative body of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City caused a notice to appear in The Daily Transcript, which is a newspaper of general circulation in the City, on July 19, 1985, to the effect that a public hearing would be held by this City Council on August 5, 1985, regarding the issuance of bonds by the Authority and the nature and location of the Project; and

WHEREAS, this City Council held the said public hearing on such date, at which time an opportunity was provided to present arguments both for and against the issuance of such bonds and the nature and location of the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


1. This City Council does hereby find and declare that the above recitals are true and correct.

2. Pursuant to Section 103(k) of the Code, this City Council hereby approves the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority to provide financing for the Project. It is the purpose and intent of this City Council that this resolution constitute approval of the issuance of bonds by the applicable elected representative of the issuer and the applicable elected representative of the governmental unit having jurisdiction over the area in which the Project is located, in accordance with said Section 103(k).

3. This City Council hereby reconfirms its intent that the Project be acquired and constructed and hereby further determines that it is appropriate for the Authority to issue bonds to finance such construction and acquisition

4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
