RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 263941

ADOPTED ON AUG 20 1985

WHEREAS, the San Diego Opportunities Industrialization Center, while operating a job training center in San Diego for the past five years, has provided a "hand-up" instead of a "hand-out" to minorities in San Diego seeking job training; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Opportunities Industrialization Center has trained and placed more than 900 San Diegans in jobs; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Opportunities Industrialization Center has trained and placed in meaningful jobs many persons formerly on the welfare roles, thereby giving them a renewed purpose in life; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Opportunities Industrialization Center operates a "feeder program" designed to provide "remedial help" to job seekers without basic skills, help not provided by other job training programs; and


WHEREAS, the more than 100 Opportunities Industrialization Centers nationwide, as part of the most successful job training program in America, have fought job discrimination against black and hispanic Americans, while recruiting and training more than 800,000 people in jobs; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Opportunities Industrialization Center will join with the community from September 1 through 8, 1985, to bring the message of the San Diego Opportunities Industrialization Center to the public; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the week of September 1 through 8, 1985, be and it is hereby declared to be "Opportunities Industrialization Center Week."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council extends this expression of gratitude to the San Diego Opportunities Industrialization Center for its display of community concern and activity on behalf of the unemployed minorities of San Diego.
