WHEREAS, the proposal was evaluated positively and has been funded in the amount of \$50,000 and the Regional Employment and Training Consortium staff is currently working with the San Diego

Unified School district staff toward program implementation when school opens this month to train thirty-three minority students in its initial year; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed appropriate to express and authorize
City participation in the program concept so that the objectives
of the program may be encouraged and assisted; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has so indicated to members of the City Council in his memorandum dated August 29, 1985, setting forth therein two (2) recommendations in pursuance thereof; and


WHEREAS, the recommendations are presented to the City
