RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 264517

ADOPTED ON NOV 25 1985

WHEREAS, the City has been approached by the Common Sense Coalition of Colorado to oppose the transporting of nuclear waste materials through the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, hearings are scheduled by the Senate and House subcommittees concerning the matter; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for such hearings to be conducted by Congress and, in preparation for and connection therewith, investigative actions taken by the concerned agencies of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommended that approach in his Report No. 85-530, dated October 23, 1985 and further recommended that the City take no position at this time regarding the transport of nuclear waste materials through Colorado; and


WHEREAS, on October 28, 1985, the Rules Committee reviewed the above cited report and recommendations therein and approved such by a 4-0 vote and now forwards same to the full Council for action; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council expresses support of the need for congressional hearings to review all the criteria which will be used, including transportation routes, for the selection of nuclear waste disposal sites.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the entire issue of location and transportation of nuclear waste materials be referred to the appropriate State of California agencies for investigation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council, for and on behalf of The City of San Diego, expresses no position, at this time, in opposition to the transport of nuclear waster materials through the State of Colorado.
