## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 264765

ADOPTED ON DEC 17 1985

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE REGISTRAR OF VOTERS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO TO PERFORM CERTAIN SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS TO BE HELD ON FEBRUARY 25, 1986 AND, IF NEEDED, JUNE 3, 1986.

WHEREAS, Roger Hedgecock, Mayor of The City of San Diego, has resigned the office of Mayor of The City of San Diego, thereby creating a vacancy in the office of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Charter of The City of San Diego provides that in the event of a vacancy occurring in the office of the Mayor the Council shall have authority to fill such vacancy by appointment but in the event the Council shall fail to fill such vacancy by appointment within (30) days after the vacancy, the Council must immediately cause an election to be held to fill such vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on December 16, 1985 adopted Resolution No. R-264751 declaring its intention to call Special Municipal Elections to be held on February 25, 1986 and, if needed, on June 3, 1986, to fill said vacancy by election; and

WHEREAS, the Charter provides that at said election a person shall be elected to serve for the remainder of such unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be economical and in the public interest to have the Registrar of Voters of the County of San

Diego perform for The City of San Diego certain services in regard to said elections; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be and is hereby requested to authorize and direct the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego to perform the following services, under the direction and supervision of the City Clerk of The City of San Diego, in connection with the Special Municipal Elections:

- 1. Furnish a tabulation of the number of registered voters in each Councilmanic district by precinct;
- 2. To examine and verify the signatures on nominating petitions;
- 3. To negotiate and secure the locations for polling places and secure the services of three (3) persons for each precinct to serve as members of the various precinct boards and furnish a list of same for filing in the office of the City Clerk;
- 4. Prepare and furnish for each election three (3) copies of the Index to the Great Register, together with supplements thereto:
- 5. Cause to be printed the requisite number of sample ballots, official ballots, polling place slips, rosters, tally books and other necessary forms;
- 6. Furnish and address for each election the envelopes necessary to mail sample ballots to the registered voters of the City;

- 7. Insert the sample ballots and other printed matter into envelopes for mailing, and cause the same to be mailed, as required by law;
- 8. Assemble the election material and supplies into ballot bags for delivery to the various precincts;
  - 9. Issue absent voter ballots as required by law;
- 10. Make all necessary arrangements for the delivery and pickup of chairs, tables and booths, and for the delivery of the ballot bags for the various precincts;
- 11. Make arrangements for answering the telephone at the Registrar's office between 6:30 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., and after 5:00 p.m. on each election day;
- 12. Receive the returns of the elections and supplies, and arrange for the issuance of bulletins of the returns of each election on the night of the election;
- 13. Sort and assemble the election material and supplies in preparation for the canvassing of the returns of the elections;
- 14. Canvass the returns of the elections, including absent voter ballots;
- 15. Furnish a tabulation of the number of votes given in each precinct;
- 16. Furnish a tabulation of the number of votes given in each Councilmanic district by precinct; and
- 17. Make all arrangements and take the necessary steps to pay the members of the Precinct Boards, the Polling Place rentals, and the persons returning the ballot bags.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in order to facilitate conducting the Special Municipal Election on such short notice, the Registrar is requested to use the same vendors, where possible, for printing, mailing and other products and services, that were successfully used in the last two County elections. This request shall also apply to the Special Municipal Election to be held on June 3, 1986, if such election is required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be and is hereby requested to authorize and direct the Auditor and Controller of the County of San Diego to assist the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego in the conduct of the work by the drawing of the warrants for the payment of the members of the Precinct Boards, the Polling Place rentals and the persons returning the ballot bags, in the amounts to be specified by the ordinances of The City of San Diego calling said elections.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County of San Diego shall be reimbursed in full for the services performed by the Registrar of Voters for the City of San Diego in connection with the election services herein described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of San Diego agrees to indemnify and to save free and harmless the County, its officers, agents and employees from expense or liability, including reasonable attorneys fees, as the result of an election contest

initiated pursuant to the provisions of Division 13 of the Elections Code of the State of California after conduct of these elections.
