ADOPTED ON FEB 10 1986

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII, ARTICLE 5, DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 75.0112 BY ADDING SUBSECTIONS (J) AND (K) RELATING TO DRIVER'S IDENTIFICATION CARDS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VII, Article 5, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending section 75.0112 by adding subsections (j) and (k) to read as follows:

SEC. 75.0112 DRIVER'S IDENTIFICATION CARDS.

(a) through (i) No change.

(j) The City Manager is authorized to issue temporary paratransit driver identification cards pending the approval or denial of an application for a regular paratransit driver identification card. No temporary paratransit driver identification card shall be issued without the satisfactory completion of a local law enforcement agency record check of the applicant. Any temporary identification card so issued shall be valid for a period not to exceed 90 days or until the date of approval or denial of the application for a regular paratransit driver identification card, whichever shall occur first. The issuance of a temporary identification card hereunder shall not authorize the

operation of a paratransit vehicle following the denial of the application while pending the resolution of any appeal otherwise provided for in section 75.0116 of this Code.

(k) The City Manager shall establish nonrefundable filing fees to defray the costs of processing regular and temporary driver identification cards. These fees shall be listed in the Composite Rate Book maintained by the City Clerk.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
