BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 7, Division 26, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Sections 27.2607 and 27.2610 to read as follows:

SEC. 27.2607 PETITION CONTENTS-REFERENDUM

The petition shall consist of sheets of white paper uniform in size with dimensions no smaller than 8½ by 11 inches or greater than 8½ by 14 inches. If the petition contains more than one sheet of paper, it shall be fastened together securely. The signature sheets for voters shall be in the following form:

Section 2. That Chapter II, Article 7, Division 27, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by amending Sections 27.2710, 27.2711 and 27.2714 to read as follows:
